

Faculty Advisor

The Athens University of Economics and Business has established the role of Faculty Advisor for postgraduate students, in order to support them during their studies. The Faculty Advisor is the point of contact for students on issues related to their academic progress, their participation in the academic community and their professional development and has the following responsibilities. The advisor:

- a) Provides advice and clarification on the Postgraduate Program and the content and requirements of the courses offered.
- b) Provides advice and guidance on the selection of the Graduation Project topic.
- c) Provides advice and suggests solutions, where possible, in case of learning difficulties and attending courses.
- d) Encourages students to make use of the infrastructures and services offered, such as the laboratories, the library, etc.
- e) Provides advice and guidance on the possibility of carrying out internship and mobility actions through the Erasmus+ Program or other programs.
- f) Encourages students to participate in the academic community and the activities organized within it (e.g., attending seminars, conferences and workshops, volunteering, etc.)
- g) Provides support in case of any problems (e.g., personal, academic, learning difficulties) that might create obstacles and difficulties in the studies and students' performance and by giving advice on how to deal with them and/or by referring them to other structures (e.g., health services, counselling, etc.).
